I was a religious and political leader in my village in western India. The people in the village looked up to me. I had a good-paying job selling alcohol, and I tasted plenty of alcohol myself. But in spite of my standing in the village, I felt spiritually unfulfilled.

Then one day an Adventist pastor visited the village. I'd never heard of Adventists before, but this pastor went from home to home sharing God's love with us. I listened with interest as he told me that Jesus Christ could give me deliverance from alcohol and fill me with God's peace.

I was excited about this news and told others what this pastor was telling me. But some people didn't like what he was saying to the villagers; they turned against him and beat him. But three months later the pastor returned to the village and visited me. This time no one tried to stop him. He held meetings, and about 50 people came to hear him speak of the love of God.

I was touched by what the pastor said and I wondered how these people could have beaten this man. I saw the Holy Spirit at work as some of the very people who had beaten the pastor were now listening to him preach God's Word.

SDAH #86: How Great Thou Art

BIBLICAL TESTS OF A PROPHET GOD'S LAST DAY PEOPLE WILL HAVE THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

Rev. 12:17 ...who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ."

Rev. 19:10 "...For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

Here are the final six of the twelve tests of a prophet.

Test Number Seven: 2 Peter 1:20

A true prophet does not give his own interpretation of scripture. Every prophecy he or she proclaims will agree with already established truth. If they receive new light, it must agree with the old light God has already given.

Test Number Eight: 2 Peter 1:21

A true prophet prophesies in the name of the Lord, not in his own name. A true prophet will manifest the fruits of that same spirit because he or she speaks through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Test Number Nine: 1 Corinthians 14:3

A true prophet gives direction to God's true church. And a true prophet's messages will cover all of these three areas: Edification -- to instruct morally; Exhortation -- this means to strongly advise; and Comfort - to soothe in distress or sorrow, to console. All of these three things will be exemplified by a true prophet.

Test Number Ten: Isaiah 8:19-20

A true messenger of God will keep all of God's Ten Commandments.

Test Number Eleven: 1 John 4:1-3

A true prophet believes in the incarnation of Jesus Christ, and will never question the fact that Jesus came in man's fallen nature, in our fallen flesh. The Bible says any person, or church, claiming that Jesus Christ came to this earth in any other way, than in the fallen flesh that you and I have, is the spirit of antichrist.

Test Number Twelve: Matthew 7:15-16

Look at the fruits of a ministry, look at the fruits of a messenger. Are they preaching the truth, or lining their own pockets?
